DIAMOND contains 160g/l 2,4-D and 240g/l glyphosate as a soluble concentrate formulation.

It controls annual and perennial weeds in amenity grassland, amenity vegetation, grassland, green cover on non-crop producing land, hard surfaces (railway ballast only), orchards and stubbles.

Rapidly eliminates weeds within stubble. Compared to straight glyphosate, this product controls difficult to kill weeds such as Black Bindweed; volunteer oilseed rape and several other broadleaved weeds. Kills weeds on railway ballasts.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Operator protection:

Engineering control of operator exposure must be used where reasonably practicable in addition to the following personal protective equipment.

WEAR SUITABLE PROTECTIVE CLOTHING (COVERALLS), SUITABLE PROTECTIVE GLOVES AND FACE PROTECTION (FACESHIELD) when handling the concentrate. WEAR SUITABLE PROTECTIVE GLOVES when handling contaminated surfaces. However, engineering controls may replace personal protective equipment if a COSHH assessment shows that they provide an equal or higher standard of protection. WASH CONCENTRATE from skin and eyes immediately. WASH HANDS AND EXPOSED SKIN before meals and after work. WHEN USING DO NOT EAT, DRINK OR SMOKE. IF YOU FEEL UNWELL, seek medical advice (show the label where possible).

Environmental protection:

DO NOT CONTAMINATE SURFACE WATERS OR DITCHES with chemical or used container. DO NOT ALLOW DIRECT SPRAY from horizontal boom sprayers to fall within five metres of the top of the bank of a static or flowing waterbody, unless a Local Environment Risk Assessment for Pesticides (LERAP) permits a narrower buffer zone or within one metre of the top of a ditch which is dry at the time of application. Direct spray away from water. This product qualifies for inclusion within the Local Environment Risk Assessment for Pesticides (LERAP) scheme. Before each spraying operation from a horizontal boom sprayer, either a LERAP must be carried out in accordance with the 'Local Environment Risk Assessment for Pesticides Horizontal Boom Sprayers' booklet available from the HSE Chemicals Regulation Directorate's website or the statutory buffer zone must be maintained. The results of the LERAP must be recorded and kept available for three years. Do not contaminate water with the product or its container. (Do not clean application equipment near surface water/Avoid contamination via drains from farmyards and roads.) Extreme care must be taken to avoid spray drift onto non-crop plants outside of the target area. To protect aquatic organisms/non-target plants do not apply on impermeable surfaces such as asphalt, concrete, cobblestones and other situations with a high risk of run-off.

Storage and disposal:

KEEP IN ORIGINAL CONTAINER, tightly closed, in a safe place. WASH OUT CONTAINER THOROUGHLY, and dispose of safely. This material and its container must be disposed of in a safe way. DO NOT RE-USE CONTAINER for any purpose.

Other specific restrictions:

- Do not use in or alongside hedges.
- Do not apply by hand-held equipment.
- Windfall (fruit fall to ground) must not be used as food or feeding stuff.
