

FIRST AID MEASURES

General Advice: Consult a physician. Show this safety data sheet to the doctor in attendance.

Eye contact: Remove possible contact lenses. Contamination of the eyes must be treated by thorough irrigation with water for 10 minutes, with the eyelids held open.

Ingestion: Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Rinse mouth with water. Consult a physician.

Inhalation: If breathed in, move person into fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration. If the person feels unwell consult a physician or take victim to hospital (show packaging, label or SDS to physician). Place unconscious person on the side in the recovery position. Loosen tight clothing such as a shirt collar, tie, belt or waistband. Keep at rest.
