

FIRST AID MEASURES

Eye contact: Rinse immediately with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if pain, blinking or redness persist. Rinse eyes with water as a precaution.

Ingestion: Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. Obtain emergency medical attention. Call a poison center or a doctor if you feel unwell.

Inhalation: Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. Allow victim to breathe fresh air. Allow the victim to rest.
